




### Parents/Guardians' Visit

- 01 In order to help the new students to adjust themselves in a new environment, parents and guardians are requested not to visit their wards till one month after their admission into hostel.
- 02 The parents are normally allowed to visit their wards only on Sundays from 10:00 a.m. to 05:00 p.m. with proper permission from the concerned authority.
- 03 Parents and guardians are requested to inform the security guard to meet the concerned authority and after obtaining the permission can meet their ward(s) in the designated place only and not in the rooms of the students.
- 04 The students are allowed to meet only those who are specified in the authority letter along with their photographs. No person(s) other than the persons specified will be entertained in this regard.
- 05 Parents are expected to visit their wards during visiting hours only. However, they can meet the subject teachers in the visiting room during their off time.
- 06 Emergency address and contact number must be given by all parents.

### Leave Regulations

- 01 Students are allowed to go home only during breaks as specified in the academic calendar. No requests to take the student home during School days will be entertained.
- 02 Local guardians are requested to meet their wards in the institution premises only during the visiting hours and will not request the authority to take the child to their residences for night stay or otherwise. **SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ARE NOT ENTITLED TO BE LOCAL GUARDIANS.**
- 03 Students may be allowed a maximum leave of three days for the wedding of their siblings only. This leave will not be granted during examination days or when any other important activity is going on in the college. Leave may be granted for emergency medical treatment of the students as suggested by the designated Medical Officer. Leave may be allowed in case of death or illness of a family member. But parents should see to it that they apply for such leave only when it is absolutely necessary. No request for leave other than mentioned above will be entertained.
  - 04 Parents should send their child back to the hostel within the authorized leave period; else disciplinary actions will be taken against the child. If the child is late due to illness, application for leave should be accompanied with a valid Medical Certificate.
  - 05 The Academic Calendar of Ajmal Super 40 is to be mandatorily followed.

## CODE OF CONDUCT



### Hostel Rules & Regulations

- 01 Food parcels from parents are not encouraged at all.
- 02 For ordinary ailments parents are not informed. If any child requires major treatment, parents/guardians are informed accordingly.
- 03 Students must not be given transistors, tape-recorders, I Pods, cameras, costly wristwatches or other expensive articles. **MOBILE PHONES ARE STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED** inside the campus and if found will be seized permanently with imposition of fines and / or the students may also be suspended.
- 04 Any acts of misconduct, ragging, leaving college or hostel without permission, disregard to hostel rules etc. are seriously dealt with and such students are not allowed to continue their studies further. The college authority reserves the right to ask the parents/guardians to withdraw his/her ward from the college and hostel for such aforementioned offences.
- 05 Hostel rules and regulations are to be strictly followed. Violation of hostel rules and indiscipline may result in imposition of fine or withdrawal of student from hostel.

### College Rules

- 01 Parents/Guardians are to adhere to the school rules in all respects and advise their ward(s) to abide by them.
- 02 All the students should wear the School Uniform and maintain the sanctity of the school uniform.
- 03 In case of trouble or any discomfort faced by the parents/guardians, they can discuss the matter with the concerned authority amicably.
- 04 Students must take examinations conducted from time to time in true spirit. Students using unfair means in the exams will invite disciplinary actions.
- 05 The parents/guardians will hold the institution indemnified against all claims arising through illness, accident or any other cause.
- 06 The parents/guardians will agree that in the event of their child being withdrawn during the term of the year, whatever the reason, the full fees laid down by the institution for the whole year will have to be paid by them. **THERE IS NO PROVISION OF FEE REFUND UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**
- 07 The college authority is fully empowered to expel a student from college and hostel if in their opinion the student has failed to follow the discipline of the college and his presence is detrimental to the college/hostel and the student fails to come up to the academic standard of his class.
- 08 The Project Head shall be the final authority in the interpretation of the College/Hostel rules. Matters not covered by these rules are left to the discretion of the Project Head and his decision shall be the final and bound.
